



Request for ECCN Export Control Classification Number

To whom it may concern:

The United States Bureau of Industry Security (BIS) issues ECCN numbers to identify dual-use items for products that are exported. The ECCN 5-digit alpha-numeric code describes the items and indicates licensing requirements for the product. All ECCNs are listed in the Commerce Control List (CCL), Supplement No. 1 to Part 774 of the EAR.

Christy's branded PVC, CPVC and ABS Solvent Cements, Cleaners, Primers for Plastic Piping Systems, Lubricants, and Sealants are not included on the CCL. As a result, they are given the general classification of EAR99. Products classified as EAR99 do not require a license in most situations. However, if you plan to export an EAR99 item to an embargoed country, to an end-user of concern, or in support of a prohibited end-use, you may be required to obtain a license.

The ECCN classification number for equipment and accessories will need to be verified separately, as it depends on the use and customer for such products. Please contact me or your customer service representative with the specific part number and use verification for more information.
